 - A. Autobiography (one page - typed)
 - B. Essay (Respond to Theme indicated in the application checklist – (one page - typed)
 - C. Resume (use a standard resume format)
 - Clubs and Organizations
 - Sports Teams
 - Student Body Office Awards
 - Community Service
 - After School/Weekend Jobs
 - Hobbies/Other Interests
 - D. Three Letters of Recommendation (From teachers, school administrators, or community members)
 - F. Yearbook appropriate wallet size (2.5x3.5) PRINTED PORTRAIT.
 - G. **Complete an application of intent to apply.** Go to - tinyurl.com/amae2019 – and register
